Artistic Director

Miss Melissa is a dean's list graduate from the University of Utah with a Bachelor of Fine Arts in Ballet; she emphasized in teaching, performance, and character dance. She has additional studies in anatomy and kinesiology for dancers, health and nutrition, essentials of teaching ballet, and history of ballet. During college she trained and performed with the Utah Ballet Company – the elite ballet level at the University, under Victoria Stocki and Jay Kim. She also spent three years in the Department of Ballet's Character Dance Ensemble under the direction of Richard Wasko. Post college she danced professionally with Odyssey Dance Theatre in Utah. She has almost two decades of experience teaching at several different studios; over that time she has taught ballet, pointe, tap, jazz, and contemporary, and has choreographed and staged many numbers in all these styles and more. This is Melissa's 6th year as Artistic Director of The Ballet Workshop and PBRT. She has a deep passion for educating, teaching, choreographing, and for growing the arts in the community of Enumclaw.

Note from Miss Melissa:

"Beauty and the Beast" has always been a top three for me - therefore I went into this one knowing that I would be even more particular about how each detail would come together. Looking at The Ballet Workshop students each year and imagining which story should be brought to life with that particular group of artists is so exciting - my sister and I sit and imagine.; who would be each role? How would we accomplish that special effect? What would be the challenges of that particular story? What would our dancers learn from that experience? Would it expand their artistry in a new way? Then piece by piece imagining, studying, choreographing, and creating to build something that will help our students grow. I hope that being a part of these productions brings joy, community, laughter, strength, and pride to every cast and crew member.

Each year I cannot stop myself from imagining an absolutely lavish version of the story and then sitting with my sister and asking her if it is possible. "What do you imagine?", "Can you build it?" (Duh.) She is my younger sister, for much of our life I was guiding her through and encouraging and supporting her in a bigger way. I find myself genuinely emotional at how she now supports me, guides me, says "yes of course" when I ask if she can make it happen. There is a much simpler version of the show you saw today - that would be the only version we could produce without her absolute grit, expertise, and passion that parallels mine and some days exceeds it. I cannot believe my sister believed in me and my vision enough, not only with this individual production but with every day of operating the dance studio and PBRT, to say let us make it even bigger and better.

This year, with Miss Aubrie running the jazz and contemporary programs, we came together and considered which story would provide some great opportunities for our classes in other styles than ballet. Miss Aubrie's eye for story-telling through movement is amazing - together we decided we were up for the challenge. It is so exciting to build a team that is incredibly passionate about building a production like this.

This community matters to me. I have a deep passion to bring people into the room and see if I can provide a space where they are able to be even more themselves; safe, beautiful, free, strong, passionate, and resilient. Dance is a sport, you cannot see a production like this and walk away thinking less talented dancers could have pulled it off. And even more, dance is an art - every moment matters, every detail counts, the amount of heart you put into it as a performer is a gift to every audience member to experience.

I lay my heart out on the floor each year for this studio. The audience might think it is for them, but each year this production is the most grandiose gift I am able to give to my dancers. Dancers, thank you for trusting me, working with me, and supporting me. Cheers to many many more!

Managing Director

This is Miss Jess's 2nd year as the Managing Director of both The Ballet Workshop and PBRT. She does just about everything to make the studio operate (except teach dance). Since the beginning of Miss Melissa's ownership, Miss Jess has been a part of all PBRT and Ballet Workshop productions, creating sets and bringing the story to life.
